

This is an independent study program. Once having obtained the online program, students should study the book found in the program, then complete all practice scenarios and the course exam online. Course completion cards are issued after completion of a skills session.

Objectives: At the end of this skills session the student will correctly demonstrated skills in: use of OPA and NPA airways, use of the Zoll Defibrillator, participate as a team member and leader of many practice codes, and Adult BLS skills utilizing the Smartman feedback manikin.

How to complete the online scenarios and examination:

1. For Attending Physicians, resident physicians, Nurse Practitioners, Off-site Detention care staff, Off-site clinic staff, Mental health staff, Registry, Travelers, and Volunteers:

Go to onlineaha.org and purchase the “Heartcode” program for BLS, PALS or ACLS. The fee is paid online.

- a. Complete the full course, print out the completion certificate and bring to the skills session
- b. enroll in a skills session by emailing p.nevius@ruhealth.org with your name, title, course and date of skills requested.

2. For onsite RUHS Medical Center Employee’s (Nursing and Ancillary staff) full-time, part-time, per diem and TAP:

- a. **Name and Employee number**
- b. **Title and Department**
- c. **Email address you want key(s) sent to and your phone number**
- d. **Name of course (BLS, PALS or ACLS) and Month you want for skills.**

You will receive an email back with a link to the online course and your own personal key code # to allow you free access to the course.

Complete the full course and print out the completion certificate. You may attempt the post-test online twice. Further attempts will be at your own cost.

How to complete the Medical Center skills session:

Bring the completion certificate with you as your pass into the skills session on your assigned date and time.

Skills session Fee:

For group 1 listed above: BLS Skill session is \$10 and ACLS/PALS skills session is \$20 paid at the cashier office on the lower level of the hospital.

For group 2 listed above: On-Site Hospital Employee’s with RUHS ID badge – Skill session is free.
